The programme mainly aims at developing infection prevention & control professionals (IPCP's), who specialize in implementing policies and procedures for preventing the spread of infectious agents, and to perform duties to contain HAI's and epidemic outbreaks in health care settings.

PROGRAM CURRICULUM:

On successful completion of the programme the learner will be able to understand the Role of Infection Control Staff, Principles and Practices in Infection Prevention & Control, Basic Microbiology & Epidemiology of Organisms, Disinfection, Sterilization & Environmental Cleaning, Hospital Acquired Infections (HAI) and its transmission, Infection Control Management during spread of Pandemics. Bio-Medical Waste Management, Spillage Management, PPE's and Health Care Worker Safety etc.
